


THE GRAND SPIEGELTENT

A substantial part of the decoration consists of beveled mirrors. The total length of cutting and polishing was 1200 m (4000 feet).

THE GRAND SPIEGELTENT


comes with a basic lighting plan that consists of:

3 light columns in the entrance area
3 lights over the bar, Ø 30 cm (10 inches)
8 Parisian bulbs over the boardwalks, Ø 40 cm (15 inches)
1 chandelier in the center, Ø 3 meters (118 inches)
18 lights in the niches
2 lights at the front entrance
4 light columns at the front
